

Application for Central Baptist Education Gift

All members of Central Baptist are eligible to apply. Criteria to be considered by the Committee will include:

1. The person must be an *active* member of Central Baptist.
2. The student must be actively enrolled in a matriculated program for the academic year commencing in the Fall of the year of application for the scholarship. Proof of enrollment must be received before distribution of the scholarship in the form of a Bursar's bill or class schedule.
3. By the end of the student's second or third year of study, they must complete at least one course in Philosophy, Theology, or Ethics.
4. The applicant must have demonstrated Christian commitment and active participation in some way in Central Baptist Church related activities.
5. Applicants must maintain a GPA of "C" in order to be eligible for the scholarship. The applicant must attach a copy of a transcript as proof of achieving a minimum "C" average from the college they are attending.
6. Students applying for the first year of college do not need to submit their high school transcripts.
7. A fully completed application and supporting documentation must be submitted to the Board of Christian Education by the date specified below.
